Review and collect catch information and effort data from foreign and domestic fishing in the FSM and the region and provide periodic reports to NORMA management; Oversee and supervise the NORMA Fisheries Observe Program; Coordinate and review marine research applications for marine scientific research vessel in FSM waters; analyze and provide scientific reports on the date stored in the catch report database to assess the potential interactions between different fishing methods used in FSM waters; work with regional scientist studying the tuna stocks of FSM and the region; liaise stakeholders in the Pacific Community, the Forum Fisheries Agency, the Parties to the Nauru Agreement and the Western and Central Pacific Fiseheries Commisions; assist in the accurate and timely submission of Port Sampling and Monitoring data to national and regional reporting obligations and provides status report of data yet to be submitted to NORMA; work with FSM state counterparts for fisheries crew and training recruitments; provide advice and input to national fisheries legislation; collect, file and input data on biological tuna samples; daft reports as required by NORMA management; and perform other duties as assigned.
