A. Forecasts and Warnings:

Based on knowledge of topography and characteristics of geographic areas, surface and upper air observational data, satellite, model and guidance products provides by WFO's Guam and Honolulu, and the JTWC:

B. Observation Program.

The observations program is quite extensive and includes surface, upper, air, and climatological networks. Specific programs include:

- 1. Takes, records, and disseminates Hourly METAR AND SPECI observations.
- 2. Takes, records, and disseminates upper air observations twice daily at 0000 and 1200 UTC and special upper air observations as required.
- 3. Takes, records, and disseminates 6-hourly synoptic observations at 000, 0600, 1200 and 1800 UTC.
- 4. Collects and transmits synoptic observations from second order stations.
- 5. Records and computes daily and monthly climatic data for publication by NCDC.
- 6. Collects and transmit surf observations from the area of responsibility.
- 7. Provides oversight of the SAWRS program at local airports.
- 8. Collects and disseminates COOP observations from the area of responsibility.
- 9. Provides oversight of automatic Weather Stations (AWS) in the area of responsibility.
- 10. Provides Astronomical and tidal data information for area of responsibility.
- 11. Provide tsunami data to the Pacific Tsunami Warning Center (PTWC), Hawaii, and maintain necessary liaison until the particular event has run its course.
- 12. From time to time, as workload and optimum utilization of employees dictate, and perform other duties as assigned.
